In this connection, quotations are invited from companies for conceptualization, designing and construction of exhibition on 'India-Russia bilateral cooperation' in State Duma and providing other related ancillary services as per following specifications:

**SPECIFICATION AND REQUIREMENTS**

(1) The exhibition should be made from flex using Indian design to reflect the India and Russia bilateral relationship in spheres of politics, history, defence, culture, space, nuclear power, tourism, youth, sports, etc., based on the inputs provided by the Embassy.

(2) The presentation should have:

- Visible and prominent positioning of all information in the presentation, reflecting Indian design.
- Trans lits / backlit displays/ light boxes may be used in the design of the Presentation wall.
- Video screen of minimum 42 inches.


(3) The scope of work will cover electrical fittings for presentation as well as taking care of all material provided by Embassy.

(4) The scope of work will include construction of the presentation at site well in time maintenance activities during the event and dismantling of the pavilion after the event.
