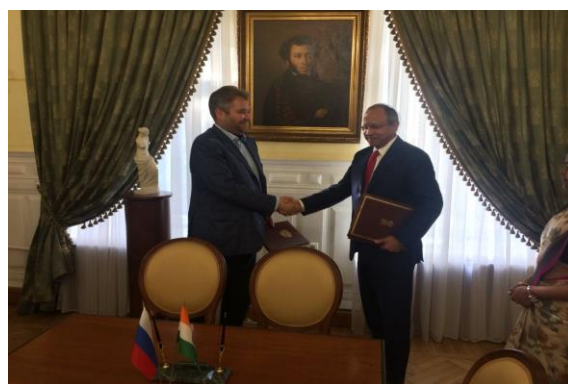

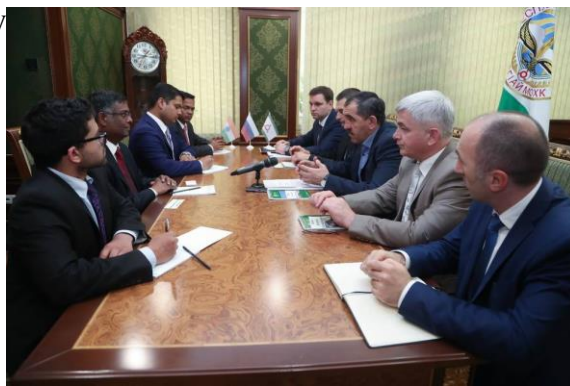


5. Consul General of India Mr. Shubham Kumar paid an official visit to Kamchatka. During the visit prospects for cooperation in various fields of economy were discussed.
