The bids should be valid for a period of three months from the date of the opening of bids.

The sealed envelope should be submitted to the attention of the Head of Chancery, Embassy of India, Moscow latest by 08.06.2021 accompanied with the proof of payment of Rbls. 20000/- to the Embassy of India School, Moscow vide bank transfer (Bank details can be obtained from the Embassy while visiting the site for inspection).
