Message

It gives me great pleasure to present the Embassy's brochure on the Indian Technical & Economic Cooperation (ITEC) Programme to our Russian friends.

2. Conceived in 1964, ITEC over the past six decades has evolved into India's flagship development cooperation and capacity building programme, aimed at sharing with countries of the Global South our own experience of development gains, technological advancement and industrial capacity. More than 200,000 government officials, private sector representatives and members of non-profit organisations from 160 plus partner countries have participated in the ITEC training programmes in these years.

3. Russia has been an ITEC partner country since 1993, and availed of nearly 1650 training slots in a wide range of courses. The most popular ITEC courses in Russia have been those dealing with Audit, English Language Proficiency, Project and Risk Management, Women Entrepreneurship, Yoga and Ayurveda etc. As you can see from the testimonials of some of the Russian participants in last year's ITEC programme, they have found the courses - and more importantly the relationships they have built with co-trainees from different countries - very useful.

4. ITEC is a fully funded programme, under which the Government of India pays for the course fee, air fare, visa fee and accommodation, besides also providing a modest cash allowance to each selected candidate.

5. This brochure is prepared to act as a guide for the training programmes available during the current academic year, i.e., 2026-27 and the application process. We encourage our Russian friends to scan through them, and apply online for the courses of interest. Please also share the information about the programmes with your friends and colleagues.

Introduction

The Indian Technical and Economic Cooperation Programme (ITEC) is the leading capacity building platform of the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India. Instituted in 1964, ITEC is one of the oldest institutionalized arrangements for international capacity building having trained more than 200,000 officials from 160+ countries in both the civilian and in the defence sector.

Building on India's vast and rich network of governance - and development-related expertise available in higher educational institutions and training facilities, ITEC offers nearly 10,000 fully-funded in-person training opportunities through nearly 400 courses offered at 100+ eminent institutes in India each year.

The training is offered in various subjects such as accounts, audit, banking and finance, management, computers, advanced computing, information technology, artificial intelligence, telecommunications, labour issues, entrepreneurship development, small medium enterprises (SME) business development, rural development, English-language proficiency, mass communication, Yoga and health, educational planning and management, tool design, pharmaceuticals, education and research, textile research, environment and renewable energy etc.

Since 2014, India has offered close to 100,000 world-class capacity building trainings and scholarships at premier institutions in India, along with a chance to experience the culture and hospitality of India. Even during the disruptions occasioned by the covid pandemic, the ITEC programme continued with its commitment to share India's development experience with the world, providing online healthcare and governance related trainings to nearly 10,000 professionals through digital platforms.

Today, ITEC utilises a bouquet of varied modalities to meet its mandate of capacity building. Even as we have re-commenced in-person (or on-campus) courses, we have also introduced modalities like eITEC (for online trainings using digital delivery platforms), ITEC-Executive (short-term policy-focussed, in-person trainings for senior government executives), ITEC-Onsite and ITEC-Expert (onsite capacity building assignments carried out by Indian experts).

Russia has been an important ITEC partner country since 1993. More than 1600 Russians have so far participated in various ITEC courses. ITEC has been of great advantage in fostering contacts between Indian entrepreneurs and the new generation of Russian decision makers, whose exposure to India's management and technological institutes would enrich their capabilities in the industrial and financial sectors. All upcoming courses on ITEC are published on Indian Embassy's social media and website on a regular basis.

The ITEC Process Flow

- All ITEC courses are listed against the ITEC Institutes that are offering them at <https://www.itecgoi.in/index> as well as <https://indianembassy-moscow.gov.in/russia-and-itec.php>
- The first step is to identify the course of your interest. If you know the institute at which the course is being offered, you may click below for a listing of institutes. Else, you may also search for by selecting the stream of your choice, and then selecting institutes which are offering courses in that stream.
- Alternatively you may type in a keyword (like name of institute, name of city in India) to search out any course.
- Once you have identified your course, click on the “Apply” button to start the application process.
The first step in the application process is to select your nationality.
- Once nationality is successfully selected from the drop down, a “Proceed” button will appear at the bottom of the page. Click on this to lead on to the next step.
- The next step is the applicant registration page. Interested applicants are required to provide details in four sections: Personal, Education/professional, employment and medical. Kindly note that these details are to be filled in sequence, and you can proceed to the next section only if all mandatory fields are filled in.
- After completing the application process, you may preview your application.
- Once you have submitted your application online, it will be visible to both the ITEC institutes, who would check your application for eligibility, as well as to the ITEC officers at the Indian Embassy in your country, who would be facilitating your travel to India.
- At this stage, please take a print out of the completed application form and submit it to the nodal/designated Government Department/Agency of your country.

How to Apply

Applicants can browse the available courses and can apply for ITEC training program by filling up the online application form at <https://www.itecgoi.in/index> or at <https://indianembassy-moscow.gov.in/russia-and-itec.php> and take a print out of filled form. This form is to be submitted to the nodal/designated Government Department/Agency of applicant's country.

Nodal/designated Department/Agency is, in turn, required to forward the applications to the Embassy of India, accredited/concurrently accredited to the nominating country along with undertaking by candidate and certification from employer (Part-II of Application Form).

Candidates may later check the status of their application by logging-in at www.itecgoi.in. *The credentials for log-in may be noted while filling up the form.*

Who can apply

- Officials in Government, Public and Private Sectors, Universities, Chambers of Commerce and Industry, etc.
- Candidates should possess adequate work experience.
- Eligibility criteria for admission to Courses
- Academic qualifications as laid down by the Institute for the Course concerned.
- Working knowledge of English required to follow the Course.
- Age between 25 to 45 years.
- Medically fit to undertake the training.

Application procedure for regular ITEC participants

Eligibility criteria:

1. Age 25-45 years
2. At least 5 years of professional experience
3. Officials of Government, Public and Private Sectors, Universities, Chambers of Commerce and Industry etc.
4. Medically fit to undertake the training
5. Academic qualifications as laid down by the Institute for the Course concerned
6. Working knowledge of English required to follow the Course

Step by step guide for applying:

On the official website of ITEC program <https://www.itecgoi.in> there will be a link to the courses for the current Financial Year and the same may be accessed through the Apply for ITEC tab in the main menu by choosing "Apply Now".

1. The applicant needs to fill in the online application form and then print out the form.
2. Page 4 of the application form – English language proficiency - has to be either signed by an Institute supported by certificates/diploma etc. If the applicant has a valid language certificate (CAE, TOEFL, IELTS etc.) she/he can attach a language certificate with the rest of the documents. If not – she/he should have an interview with ITEC coordinator to identify the level of English language)
3. Page 5 of the application form – medical certification - has to be filled in the clinic or any other medical institution, signed and stamped. (It is recommended for the applicant to get the medical form signed by an English speaking doctor).
4. Page 6 - the applicant has to sign the undertaking.
5. Page 7 – educational and professional certification – has to be verified, signed and stamped in the Chamber of Commerce of the region or by the head of institution/organisation where the applicant is employed.
6. Please send the scanned copy of duly filled application form along with all documents containing necessary stamps and signatures as well as copy of Russian international passport to the ITEC coordinator through email info1.moscow@mea.gov.in.
7. After successful validation from the ITEC coordinator, the original application form along with the necessary documents has to be sent to ITEC Coordinator, P&I Wing, Embassy of India in Moscow with a courier service. The address is: Embassy of India, Press and Information Wing, 9, Vorontsovo Polye, Moscow, Russian Federation. The address may also be taken from the Embassy of India, Moscow website.
8. When the form is complete, it will be reviewed by the ITEC coordinator and forwarded to MEA and Institute for their consideration.
9. Successful application will receive confirmation from Ministry of External Affairs along with itinerary.
10. Applicant applies for paper visa online (<https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/>) and sends the visa application form to the ITEC coordinator to check the correctness of the visa application.
11. ITEC coordinator prepares relevant documents to support visa application of ITEC applicant.
12. The applicant needs to visit the Indian Embassy 5 working days before the official day of departure with the original copy of visa application form and supporting documents from ITEC coordinator.
13. Applicant receives the visa and departs from Russia.

General Information

Applications should reach the Embassy of India preferably 3 months before the commencement of the Course. Upon selection, the Embassy of India will inform the nodal/designated Department/Agency of the nominating country and the candidate.

Selected candidates are required to familiarize themselves fully with the living conditions in India and about the Institute through the Institute's website.

Decision regarding acceptance of applications/nominations rests solely with the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India.

For any further information/clarification, applicants are requested to contact Embassy of India Moscow.

General Conditions

Participants must ensure that they have appropriate visa for India, valid for the entire duration of the training course before departure. While the Visa for India would be provided by respective Indian Mission on gratis basis, participants should obtain required transit visas, if any, on their own.

Participants are required to take Yellow Fever and any other prescribed vaccination, if so required as per WHO protocols, well before their departure to India (at least 10 days before the date of travel) otherwise they are liable to be quarantined at the airport on their own cost.

Participants are required to obtain from the Indian Mission the contact details of the Course Coordinator and the Training Institute and should keep the Institute informed of their travel plans well in advance.

Participants should familiarize themselves with the weather conditions at the place of training and carry appropriate clothing with them.

Participants are required to conduct themselves with discipline and abide by conduct rules, regulations and guidelines as stipulated by both the nominating Government and the Government of India.

Participants are required to abide by the rules of the university/institution/establishment in which the participant is selected to undergo the training as well as participate in all Course-related activities including submission of periodic assessments/tests conducted by the Institute.

Participants may be taken on educational study tour(s) as part of their Course Curriculum. This also typically includes visits to different Indian heritage sites/places of interest located in the geographical vicinity of the institute. Participation in the study tour is mandatory.

Participants are required to complete the training Course. Participants must ensure that there are no family or official commitments during the training programme. Request for leave during the course may not be acceded to by the Government of India. Participants

are required to return to their countries upon completion of the training Course.

Participants who leave the Course midway without prior intimation/permission of the Ministry of External Affairs or remain absent from the Course are required to refund the cost of training including airfare to Government of India.

Participants must refrain from engaging in any political activity and/or any form of employment for profit or gain while on training.

Candidates must not to carry any arms, ammunition drugs or any other prohibited and illegal items.

Participants are not allowed to bring along their spouses or families for the duration of the Course. No such request will be entertained by Government of India.

ITEC sponsorship could be canceled at any time due to unsatisfactory conduct, breach of conditions of the Programme, violation of rules of the institute/university/establishment, failure to make satisfactory progress in the training Course or for other sufficient cause as determined by the Government of India.

Female participants are advised that if they are pregnant, issues related to their pregnancy will not be covered during their training on India.

ITEC sponsorship may be canceled at any time due to unsatisfactory conduct, breach of conditions of the Programme, failure to make satisfactory progress in the training Course or for other sufficient reasons as determined by the Government of India.

If any special assistance is required by a participant during his/her stay in India, it should be intimated to Mission as well as to the concerned Institute prior to departure for India.

Participants are advised to join social media handles of ITEC on Facebook/Twitter to get useful information from the ITEC community.

Expenses Covered under ITEC programme :

Air Fare

Excursion/economy class air tickets for travel from the airport nearest to their place of working/residence in their respective home countries, to their place of training in India and back.

Visa

Visa is issued gratis to the participants. Prior to departure for training in India, participants are advised to apply for Visa to the Embassy of India, accredited or concurrently accredited to their country. Visa issued for a particular training programme cannot be utilized for some other purpose.

Course Fees

Fees charged by the training institutes are borne by the Government of India.

Accommodation

Accommodation is provided by the Training Institute in a hostel/hotel and the charges on this account are borne by the Government of India. While generally accommodation is provided on single occupancy, there could be instances of accommodation being provided on double occupancy basis. (Type of accommodation being provided by the Institute is available at ITEC portal). Participants are required to pay for availing services such as: a. Room service, b. Laundry, c. Local and outstation telephone calls, fax, etc.

Living Allowance

The participants will receive a daily living allowance (currently INR 1200/1500 per day). Disbursement of this Allowance will be made by the Institute on a weekly/fortnightly basis (as decided by the Institute) after deducting charges for meals, as participants are required to bear expenditure for meals from the Living Allowance. In case institute does not make any arrangement for provision of meals,

the participant will receive the entire daily living allowance. Participants are advised to bring some extra money with them for any particular individual needs they may have, including special dietary needs, shopping and other out-of-pocket expenses.

Book Allowance

The institute will provide the necessary training material, handouts, books, e-study material or any other documents which are necessary for training/self-study including a welcome-kit to the participants. In some cases, the institute may specify certain books and suggest that the participants should purchase the same. Cost on such purchases will be borne by Government of India.

Study Tour

An educational-cum-sightseeing study tour is an integral part of many courses. They also serve to familiarize the participants with Indian culture and history and are compulsory. Government of India bears the cost of such study tours during the Course.

Medical Facility

Participants selected for training Courses are expected to be medically fit. The Government of India will cover medical treatment only for ailments of immediate and emergency nature occurring in India. No medical reimbursement will be provided for ailments of chronic nature or for pre-existing medical condition. Participants must carry their medicines for chronic ailments like diabetes, hypertension, etc. and have to bear the expenditure for medicines and consultation of doctors on their own.
